EXHIBITION RULES

to the Dwarf Rabbit World Championships and $Dwarf \ Rabbit \ Youth \ World \ Championships$ on the 23^{rd} and 24^{th} of November 2019 in A (Austria) – 4600 Wels, Messeplatz1



1. The Dwarf Rabbit World Championships and the Junior Dwarf Rabbit World Championships are connected to the 23rd RÖK-Bundesschau in Wels (Austria) and are organized by the Zwergkaninchenclub Österreich (Dwarf Rabbit Club Austria) (ZKCÖ). The admission of the exhibitors is carried out by the organizer ZKCÖ.

2. The exhibition includes male and female rabbits of the following breeds:

- Dwarf loop
- Check dwarf
- Ermine rabbits
- Luttenbacher ermine rabbits
- Color dwarf rabbits
- Dwarf rabbit polish, white
- Dwarf rabbit polish, colored
- Dwarf-satin
- Dwarf lop-rexe
- Dwarf rexe
- Dwarf-fox-rabbit, white
- Dwarf-fox-rabbit, colored
- Dwarf-lop-lions head
- Dwarf-lions head
- Dwarf angora, white
- Dwarf angora, colored
- Dwarf loop Satin
- Dwarf loop Angora

The Assessment is carried out according to the National Standard by the RÖK. Objections to the assessment can be made in accordance with §21 of the General Exhibition Regulations of the RÖK. Complaints are only possible during the exhibition and can only affect your own rabbits. In all disputes concerning this exhibition, the exhibition management decides to the exclusion of the ordinary legal process.

3. Registration form- for each breed and color a separate registration form is to be used. When registering, only breed, color, gender and sales price have to be stated. The license plates are only specified when the animals arrive. The exhibition forms are available for download on the Zwergkaninchen-World-Championship homepage (www.zwergkaninchen-wm.at)

4. Deadline is the 15th of October 2019

All registrations are the main applications and can be registered by every breeder ONLINE at: www.kleintierzucht-roek.at . If there is no internet access, the registration form has to be sent to the responsible EDV-editor of the RÖK by 15th of October 2019 (postmark) at the latest. The registration papers will be sent to each exhibitor (they will not be printed out) and can be copied if necessary.

5.Exhibition fees:

Each exhibitor has to pay a lump sum of $59 \in$ so that he can exhibit up to 4 animals. For each additional animal the demurrage is $10 \in$. The lump sum includes the demurrage for 4 animals, the entry fee, the catalog and the entrance fee – plus drinking and food cups for the aimals, which can be taken home by the exhibitor at the end of the exhibition.

Young breeders pay a lump sum of 29€ for a collection of 4 animals of a breed and color. For each additional animal the full price has to be paid.

6. Transfer fee:

For canceling or adding the sales price on the day of submission (Tuesday the 19th of November 2019) 2€ have to be paid for each change.

7. Damage report:

Damages of any kind must be reported to the exhibition management in written form immediately, with a specific description of the individual claim. **Attention: The complaint ends 6 weeks after the exhibition.**

8. Animal sales:

Private pet sales are forbidden in and during the exhibition, in the car parks and in surrounding within 500 meters.

The proceeds from the sale of the animals, **minus the processing fee of 15% of the sales price given** will be given transferred to the specified account of the association. **Therefore, necessarily with the club account, account holder and IBAN of the club specified.** Exhibitors from neighboring countries must state IBAN and BIC. A cash payment at the exhibition is not possible!

Beginning and ending of the animal sales determines the exhibition management. Sales are only valid if they are completed by the exhibition management. The sales prices indicated in the registration form are authoritative.

For forgotten Dwarf rabbits is until Saturday the 30th of November 2019 the opportunity to pick them up. After that they become property of the ZKCÖ!

9. The animals will arrive on Tuesday , 19th of November 2019 from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m. Later arriving rabbits are not entitled to the prize distribution.

During posting, the registration numbers and the company code have to be entered on the registration forms.

The assigned box number must be written by the exhibitor with waterproof black marker (EDDING 3000) in the right ear of the rabbit.

The club identifier may not be readable. If the club mark is readable or overwritten as black, the animal is eliminated from the exhibition.

10. Veterinary certificates

are required, the necessary forms will be sent with the B-Bogen and can be downloaded on the homepage (www.zwergkaninchen-wm.at). There is no compulsory vaccination for rabbits.

11. Competition:

Dwarf rabbit World Cup:

World Champion: In 24 animals of one breed and color, both sexes of 3 exhibitors a world champion will be awarded (minimum points: 376). If 48 animals from 5 exhibitors are registered in one breed and color, a 1st Vice World Champion title will be awarded, with 72 animals and 7 exhibitors a 2nd Vice World Champion will be awarded.

Breeds of the same color with less than 24 animals are merged according to standard and the best collection receives the World Champion Title.

World Winner: From 24 animals of a breed the animal with the highest rating is awarded a World Champion, from 48 animals of the opposite sex a World Champion is awarded as well.

Youth Dwarf rabbit World Cup:

Youth World Champion: In 18 animals of one breed and color, both sexes of 2 exhibitors a Youth Champion is awarded (minimum points 376). If 36 animals from 4 exhibitors are registered in one breed and color a 1st Youth Vice World Champion Title will be awarded, with 54 animals and 6 exhibitors a 2nd Youth Vice World Champion will be awarded.

Races of the same color with less than 18 animals are merged according to the standard and the best collection receives the Youth World Champion Title.

Youth World Winner: From 18 animals of a breed the animal with the highest rating is awarded a Youth World Champion, from 36 animals of the opposite sex a Youth World Champion is awarded as well.

The issue of the honorary prizes takes place exclusively under presentation of the B-Bogen of the exhibitor!

12. Collection size and information on the calculation of the World Champion Titles:

Individual animals and collections can be exhibited. The collections consist of 4 to 6 animals of a breed and color of both sexes. Age up to 6 years. Dwarf rabbits must be self-bred. A exhibitor can also exhibit several collections, but only with 6 animals. Only the last collection can consist of 4-6

animals. For each collection, the points of the four highest rated animals are counted together, but at least 1 animal per sex must be used. In the case of equality of points, the fifth animal is used before the sixth animal. If the collections continue to be equal, the procedure is the same as for the individual animals. In case of equality of points after checking the individual positions, two titles will be awarded.

Certificates and honorary prizes will be awarded to world champions and world winners. Honorary prizes are awarded for all donated cash prizes and awarded to the exhibitors with the donated honorary and outrage prizes. The honor prize will be closed on Sunday at 12 noon. The B-Bogen of the exhibitor must be presented for the price collection. Uncleared prices go back without exception to the exhibition management.

- **13.** By submitting the application, the exhibitor expressly agrees with the exhibition regulations, the publication of the data recorded in the registration form and all exhibition results in the exhibition catalog and on the internet. The personal data of the exhibitor are stored in the database of the RÖK. By signing the registration form, the exhibitor, one of the legal representatives of youth exhibitors, agrees to the publication of all personal data in the catalog. Furthermore, these data and photos, including those of the animals, can be transmitted to print- and other media. Lists of exhibitor data can be published on the homepages of the RÖK and the ZKCÖ.
- **14.** Should the Dwarf Rabbit World Championships and the Junior Dwarf Rabbit World Cup due to force majeure, unforeseen events, epidemics or similar, not take place the costs incurred until cancellation (hall rental, purchases, ect.) are deducted as a percentage of the cost contribution.
